### Puppets and more

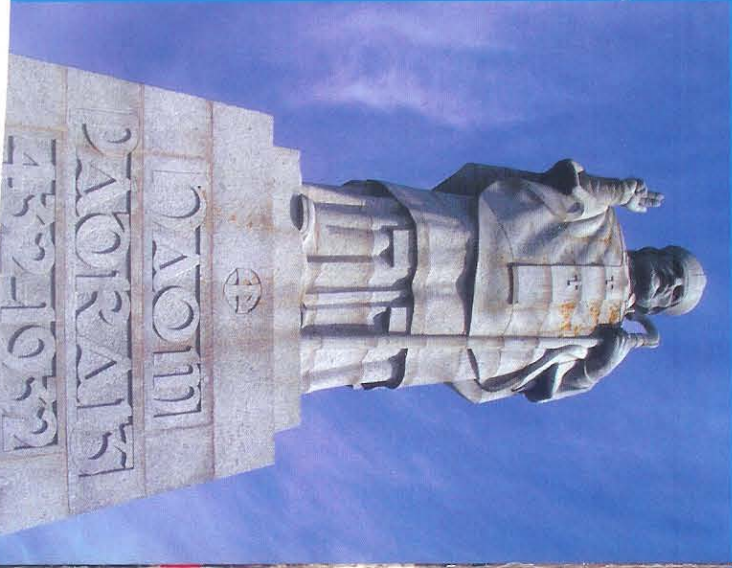
If you're interested, there is training in children's evangelism and puppet ministry.

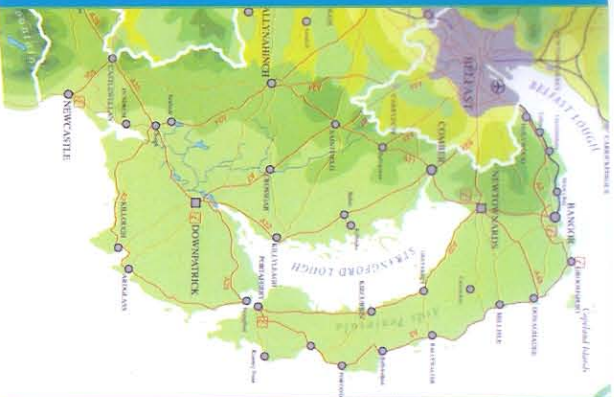
